

Understanding TWCCRD Investigative Role. Reasonable Accommodation Complaints

As a landlord there is a legal obligation to provide and/or make “Reasonable Accommodations”. A reasonable accommodation is a change, exception, or adjustment to a rule, policy, practice or service that may be necessary for a person with a disability to have an equal opportunity to use and enjoy a dwelling, including public and common-use spaces.

Questions such as:

What and When you can ask for verification, Weight/Breed limits, Direct Threat, Amenity Areas, Rent/ Fee/deposits, Insurance requirements, will all be answered in this session.

You will also learn about the Investigators role when there is a complaint and what is expected of you. Did you know maintenance personnel need To know how to address these requests also?
